

THE IMPORTANCE OF EDX TESTING (ELECTRODIAGNOSTICS TESTING)

In order to better understand the conditions affecting your health, your doctor has suggested you have a one or more types of EDX testing. These tests will tell your doctor if you have any damage to your nervous system by measuring how specific nerves in your arms and legs respond to mild stimulation.

Injuries or diseases, such as diabetes, can affect your nerves and muscles, causing weakness, numbness and pain. These simple tests prescribed by your doctor can help determine the extent of the neurological distress you may be experiencing. The more information your doctor has about your condition, the more effectively you can be treated.

There are two categories of EDX studies: one set evaluates muscle function and the other evaluates nerve function. The tests are done in less than an hour by a licensed technician or physiatrist (a specialist trained and certified in this area). Both tests are minimally invasive and virtually painless.

Small electrode patches placed on your skin will register the gentle impulses sent by the testing device. This response is a valuable measurement that will be used to accurately diagnose your condition. The TLC doctor administering your procedure will be happy to answer any questions you may have.



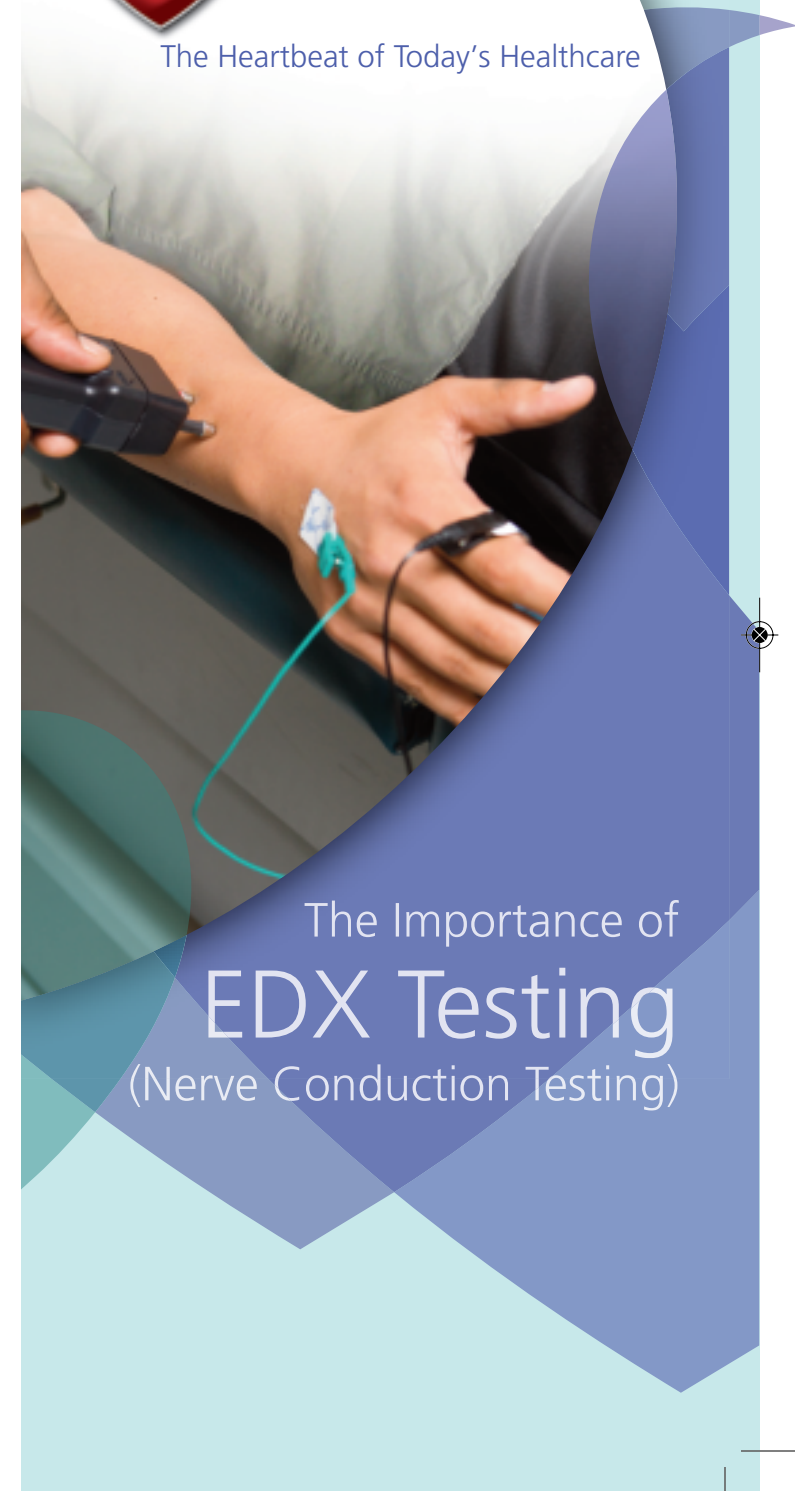
